



# RECYCLING IN NASSAU COUNTY



What to Recycle	Where to Recycle
<b>Newspapers</b>	County's 8 drop-off sites; Fernandina Beach curbside program; ARC – Nassau; most Public Schools
<b>Aluminum Cans</b>	County's 8 drop-off sites; Fern. Beach curbside; ARC – Nassau; most Public Schools; Habitat for Humanity bins; ARC – Nassau;
<b>Glass Containers</b> – clear, green, brown, sorted	County's 8 drop-off sites, Fernandina Beach curbside
<b>Paper</b> (all white & colored papers except shiny paper & envelopes with see-through windows)	ARC-Nassau – US Hwy. 17, 1 mile north of A1A – 225-9355
<b>Plastic Containers</b> – Types 1 & 2 ONLY (look for number on containers)	5 drop-off sites on Amelia Island. Call 277-7388 for locations and more information.
<b>Cardboard</b>	Fernandina Beach curbside; bin behind ARC-Nassau; bin in Fernandina Library parking lot
<b>Magazines</b>	N. Jax Recycling-Fernandina, 8 <sup>th</sup> & Lime Streets, 261-4498
<b>Plastic Grocery Bags &amp; Brown Paper Bags</b>	All Publix & Winn Dixie stores
<b>Styrofoam Trays</b> -- egg cartons, foam trays	Publix store
<b>Styrofoam Packing Peanuts</b>	Mail Boxes Etc. on Sadler Rd., Ship 'N' Mail on S. 14 <sup>th</sup> St., & coastal-tel.com in Lofton Square
<b>Eyeglasses</b>	Lions Club of Yulee , 225-5686, and Baptist Medical Center – Nassau, information desk
<b>Light Metals</b> – aluminum, copper, stainless steel, brass, some car parts	Callahan Recycling – 879-4357 and N. Jax Recycling-Fernandina, 261-4498
<b>Used Motor Oil &amp; Car Batteries</b>	Fernandina Beach curbside & Landfill's recycling site
<b>Fluorescent Light Bulbs</b> – must be boxed/in carton; small recycling fee (by length of bulb)	City Electric Supply Co. – SR 200/A1A, 261-6972

*Materials currently not recycled in the county: electronic equipment, telephone books*

## How to Prepare Recyclables

**Newspapers:** Do not tie up or put in bags. Put in bins loose.

**Plastic containers:** Rinse well and remove tops.

**Glass containers, aluminum cans, Styrofoam trays:** Rinse thoroughly. Leave loose. No lids.

| <b>Callahan</b>      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Between Health Dept. &amp; County Building</li><li>• County Landfill, 3 miles north of A1A on US 1</li></ul>   |
| <b>Hilliard</b>      | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Across from Town Hall and the Library</li></ul>  |
| <b>Bryceville</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In front of the Bryceville Community Center at US 301 &amp; County Road 119</li></ul>  |

### **Other Key Recycling Locations in the County**

**ARC – Nassau** - US Hwy. 17, 1 mile north of A1A in Yulee – 225-9355. For cardboard, aluminum cans, paper, newspapers. Other items, such as clothes, are no longer accepted. If you are a business with large volume, call ARC - Nassau to arrange pick-up.

**North Jacksonville Recycling-Fernandina** -- at the corner of 8<sup>th</sup> and Lime Streets – 261-4498. For non-ferrous metals and magazines.

**Habitat for Humanity - Nassau** – Look for collection bins for aluminum cans at grocery stores, discount stores, car dealerships, etc. Call 277-0600 for more information.

**Publix** – Styrofoam trays & egg cartons, plastic grocery bags (all stores'), brown paper bags

**Winn Dixie** – Plastic grocery bags (all stores'), brown paper bags

Various shippers (see other side) for Styrofoam packing peanuts



### **Did You Know...**

- If every family and business recycled all recyclable materials, trash going to the landfill would be reduced by 75% (in weight). This would also save millions of dollars in county landfill costs.
- Recycling one aluminum can saves the amount of energy to light one 100 watt bulb for 20 hours.
